Near Misses	HUMAN ERROR	REPORT THE NEAR MISS
<p>A “near miss” can be defined as an unplanned event that did not result in injury, illness, or damage - but had the potential to do so. Only a fortunate break in the chain of events prevented an injury, fatality, or damage.</p>	<p>Human error is commonly an initiating event, a faulty process or system invariably permits or compounds the harm, and is the focus of improvement.</p>	<p>A key to any near miss report is the "lesson learned". Near miss reporters are in a position to describe what they observed about genesis of the event, and the factors that prevented loss from occurring.</p>
DID YOU KNOW ?	CONDUCTING THE INVESTIGATION	REPORT TO EHS
<p>For every serious injury, there are 10 minor injuries, 30 property damage incidents, and 600 “near misses” where no injury or damage occurs. This is known as the “near miss pyramid”.</p>	<p>By investigating the “near misses” which occur in your workplace, you greatly affect your ability to prevent more serious accidents, or even death, from occurring. The events that caused the near miss are subjected to root cause analysis to identify the defect in the system that resulted in the error.</p>	<p>Today’s near miss if left unhandled could be tomorrow’s disastrous accident. Report the Near miss in accident analysis form. Do not hide any near miss information.</p>
