As an employee, you should: Learn to work safely and take all rules seriously.</p>	<p>Report all accidents, incident and near miss to your supervisor immediately for taking corrective and preventive action to avoid the recurrence.</p>	<p>Everyone must be aware of potential hazards on the job: Poor house keeping – Slip, Trips and fall hazard Electricity - shocks, burns or fire if not handled properly. Tools – Improper tools can cause injury Poor material handling - may cause back problems or other injuries.</p>
